TRANSFER CREDIT AND COURSE WAIVER If you've previously done graduate work, you may transfer up to 9 credits toward your degree provided you received a B or better in the course and it was completed less than 10 years ago. Substitutions/waivers for a required course may be requested and granted if a student can prove proficiency with the content. Students who are granted waivers must take elective courses to replace the credits from which they have been waived. A course waiver does not result in an award of credit. TIME LIMIT Students have five years from the start of their first course to complete all the requirements for the M.S. degree. A student may petition for an extension beyond this limit in the case of significant extenuating circumstances.
