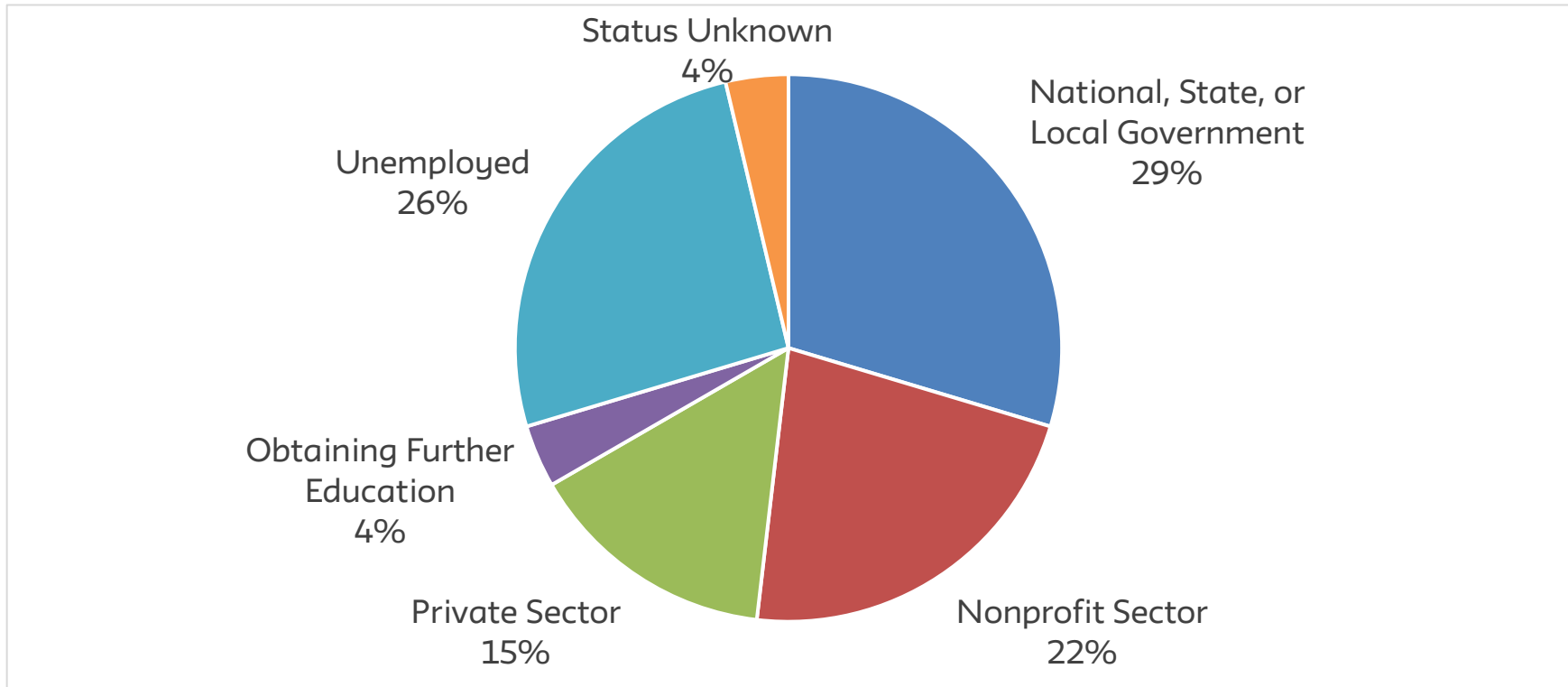
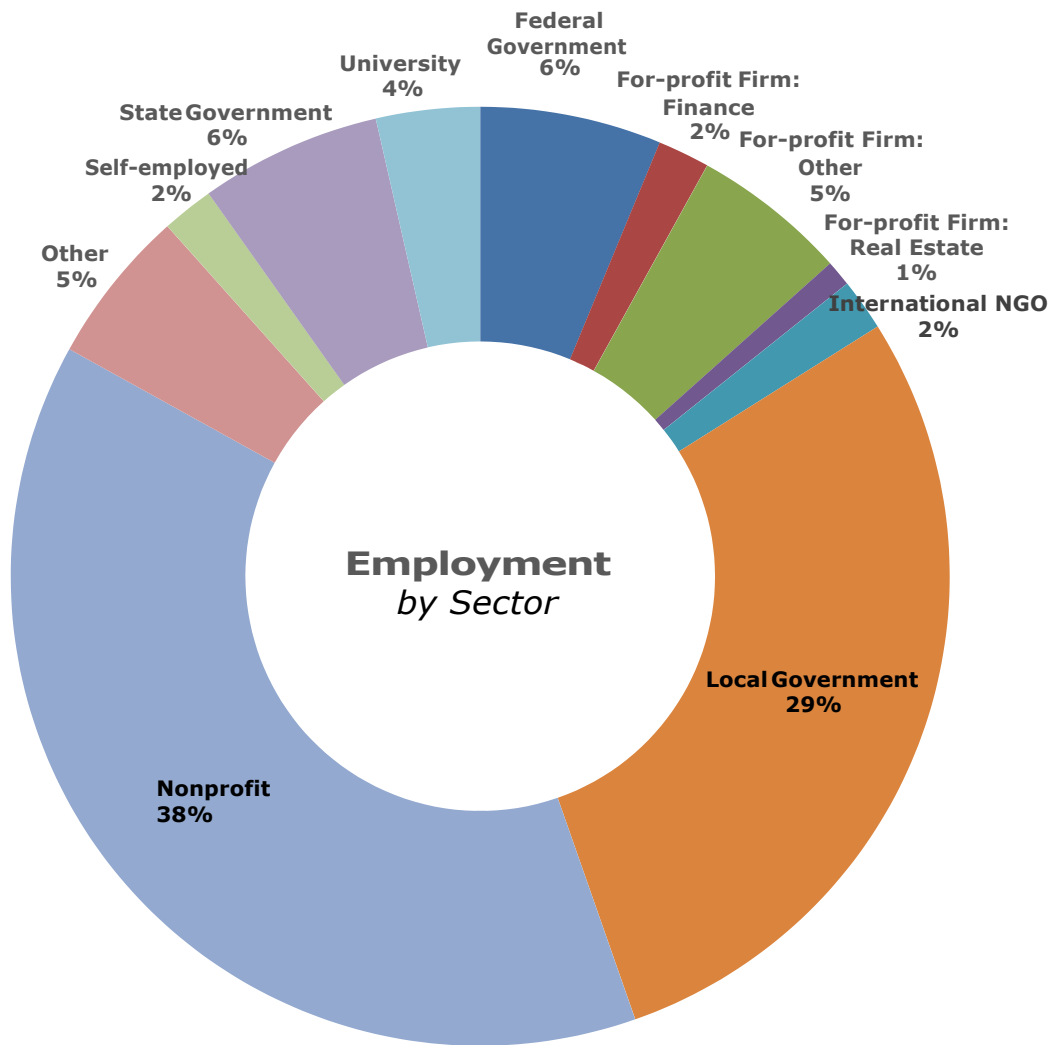

2018-2019 Degrees Conferred: 27



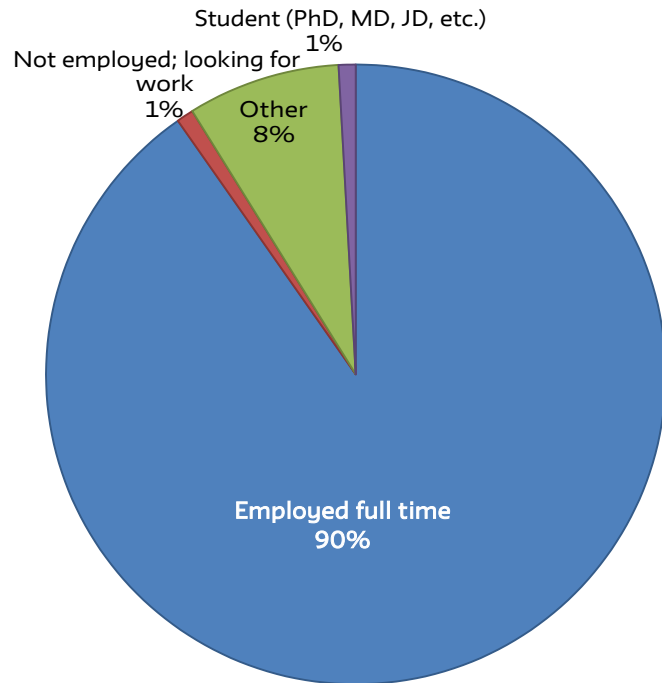

We surveyed five years of our graduates (2010-2015) to learn more about the career paths they have taken.

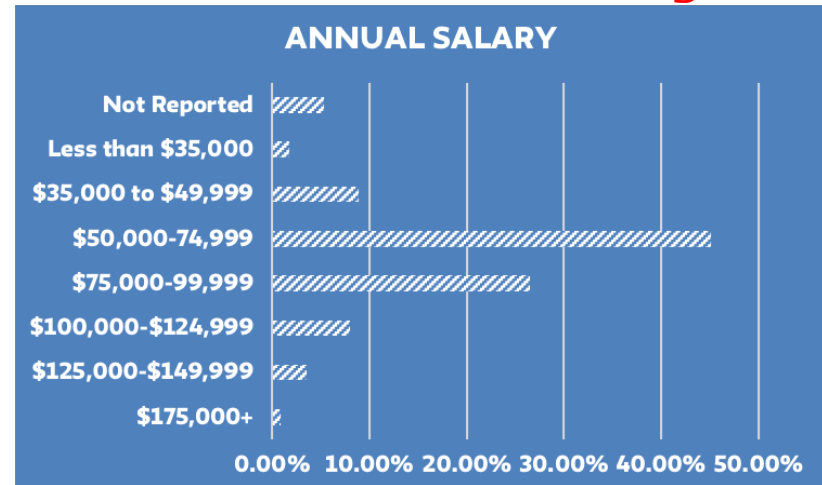
